### **Grant Application Instructions**

Marco Island Foundation for the Arts is a 501(3)© charitable non-profit organization that supports literary, visual and performing arts on Marco Island, Florida. Our mission is to promote the arts in public places on Marco Island. We are pleased to offer this Marco Island Arts Grant Program.

1. Funded grant programs must meet the mission of Marco Island Foundation for the Arts.
2. Individuals or non-profit organizations are eligible to apply.
3. Applicants and applicant organizations must be located on Marco Island, Goodland or the Isle of Capri.
4. MIFA reserves the right to award full or partial funding of applicants' project.
5. Grant applicants must use the funds only for an event or project approved for the grant. Unused monies are to be returned to MIFA after the event or project is completed.
6. A brief report of the use of funds with documentation including a copy of the city permit application must be submitted to MIFA within 30 days of the completion of the funded project.
7. Please submit two copies of the application and any supporting materials at least eight weeks before the planned event or project.

The Marco Island Foundation for the Arts considers the following criteria when evaluating the goals and feasibility of an applicant's project.

1. The project promotes the arts in public places on Marco Island.
2. Enhances the quality of life on Marco Island for residents and visitors.
3. Develops opportunities for citizens to enjoy cultural activities, particularly if provided to the public for free or at a very low cost.
4. Maintains a high level of quality, professionalism, creativity and diversity in the arts.
5. Provides liaison within the arts community.
6. Must have a reasonable chance of success considering size and scope.
