Returning Participants: When show date(s) are approved, and you have been approved for specific show dates, you can pay online or you can print out an application or an application can be snail-mailed to you for payment to be mailed back to: Priscilla MacDonald, 1580 Villa Court, Marco Island, FL 34145.

New Participants interested in being part of these events must email 3 photos of their art and 1 photo of the booth to prisjoy1@comcast.net. If you are juried in and you have been approved for specific show dates, you can pay online or print out an application or an application can be snail-mailed to you for payment to be mailed back to: Priscilla MacDonald, 1580 Villa Court, Marco Island, FL 34145.

ARTISTS MUST PAY WITHIN TWO WEEKS AFTER APPROVAL DATE. Spaces will only be held for two weeks until payment in full is received. Refunds will only be given if cancellation notification is received two months before the show date. A \$20 administration fee will be deducted from the paid booth fee. The only cost for the show is the entry fee. If you are not a MIFA member, you may join with the application and receive the members' discount.

The Committee reserves the right to reject any work deemed inappropriate.

REFUND POLICY: "If an artist pulls out of a show past the two-month notification, there will be no refunds. If the city cancels a show due to COVID related issues, we will issue a refund after deducting costs MIFA has incurred, such as advertising and permit fees.

SAFETY REGULATIONS: County regulations require all vendors to wear masks and have hand sanitizer in a visible location at their booth for all events AND comply with the 6' distance.

Rules: Original paintings, drawings, photography, mixed media, sculpture, fiber arts, jewelry and printmaking are eligible. No crafts. All work must be the work of the exhibitor.

Spaces: 10' D x 10' W will be assigned by the committee. Specific spaces can't be guaranteed. White tents are required, exceptions to be approved by the chair. Tents must have proper weights on each leg.

Locations unloading and loading: Tyler and Priscilla will have a map at the Esplanade location for parking and set-up for each artist. Check in with them before unloading. Due to Marco Island City restrictions, parking locations will be strictly enforced.

Shows at The Esplanade: 760 N. Collier Boulevard, Marco Island, FL 34145

Set-up cannot start until 8am. Vehicles can be pulled up to the front of The Esplanade for unloading. The Esplanade requires that after unloading, the exhibitors must be prepared to park their vehicle in designated areas some distance from the show area before setting up your booth. Set-up must be completed by 9:45am. Break-down begins at 4pm. Booths and merchandise must be packed up for quicker loading prior to bringing your vehicle to the front of the Esplanade. Break down must be completed by no later than 6:00pm. All garbage must be removed from the property by the artists.

The committee is there to help you have a safe and successful show. Respect for the event planners and volunteer help at the shows is expected. Issues should be resolved peacefully and without confrontation. Any disrespect or aggression will result in disqualification from all shows.
