#### ***Guidelines for this show include:***

1. Fine art and hand crafts of photographers, painters, potters, jewelers and crafters.
  2. A maximum of twenty- five artists will be accepted. Acceptance will be on a first come, first served basis. A waiting list will be maintained in case of cancellations. Be sure to send in your registration form with your payment ASAP to MIFA at the address listed above or you or you may pay online with PAYPAL.
  3. No "Specials" or "Sale Items" are allowed.
  4. Artists are permitted to work on a piece of art during the show.
  5. Artists may set up a white tent on the dome or parking lot or may display their work under the eaves of the museum using tables, easels, etc.
- Spaces under the eaves of the museum are approximately 10 ft long and provide shade most of the day.
6. Set up will begin at 8:30 am. Spaces will be assigned.
